

ONLY RAIN DOWN THE DRAIN

OFFICIAL RULES

All entries must be submitted by June 4, 2010

ELIGIBILITY

- ▶All students in grades 9-12 attending public, private, or home school full time are eligible. Students do not have to be in a film class to enter. Any graduating class students may enter contest.
- ▶The video may be completed by an individual student or a team of students working together.
- ▶There is a limit of one entry per student or team.

VIDEO

- ▶The video must be on the topic of storm water, and have the theme of "Only Rain Down The Drain," with the exception of the documentary category. Documentaries must have the theme "Urban Runoff and the Impact to Receiving Waters"
- ▶The video must be formatted in NTSC. PAL is not useful to us.
- ▶All entries must be submitted on DVD (Standard Definition). Blu-Ray discs and miniDV tapes are not useful to us.
- ▶All DVDs must be formatted in Region 1 or "No region".
- ▶Sound may be formatted in Mono, Stereo, or Dolby Digital.
- ▶Three (3) copies of the video must be submitted. The copies will not be returned.
- ▶Each copy submitted must be labeled with the entrant's name, school, and phone number.
- ▶All films must either be in English, or have English subtitles.
- ▶All submissions must contain only legally licensed audio, graphics, and video that can be freely distributed. All submissions found in non-compliance will be disqualified.
- ▶All licensed or copyrighted material must come with a license to use in the video, signed by the license and/or copyright holder, or the entry will be disqualified.
- ▶The video will be disqualified at our discretion if there is any profanity, nudity, gang related images, or overt violence. World's Greatest Resource Productions reserves the right to disqualify any video for any reason.

HOW TO ENTER

- ▶Submit the video as described above, along with the signed Entry Form, License Agreement and, if necessary, the Actor Release Form,

to WGR Southwest, Inc. The submission package may be dropped by in person or mailed.

- ▶All entries must be postmarked or received by Friday, June 4, 2010 at 5:00 P.M., in order to qualify for judging.

JUDGING / CATEGORIES

- ▶There are three categories:
 - 30 second PSA (Public Service Announcement)
 - 60 second PSA
 - 10 – 30 minute documentary
- ▶Categories will not be separated by the number of entrants, so individual students may be competing against teams of students.
- ▶Judging will focus on the following points:
 - Message (quality, accuracy, and amount of message to story)
 - Video quality (composition, camera work, color choices, special effects)
 - Audio quality (sound design, music, dialog continuity, overall cleanness of soundtrack)
 - Level of difficulty

AWARDS

- ▶Awards will be given at an award ceremony. Location and date is yet to be determined.
- ▶Finalists will be notified on Friday, June 18, 2010.
- ▶The first prize for each category will be \$300. Each category must receive at least 3 qualifying entries to be eligible for a cash prize for that category. All qualifying entrants will be considered for a \$600 best-of-show whether or not their category received enough entries to be eligible for a cash prize.
